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Message from the Company

To Unitholders

Market Summary

Global equities experienced a strong run in the first 3 quarter of 2024, largely driven by the Al-related stocks and easing inflation fears. Tech stocks, particularly in the semiconductor area with significant earnings growth, were the main contributors to double-digit returns of major indices like the S&P 500 and MSCI AC World Index. Moreover, Fed adjusted policy rate aggressively with 0.50% rate cut to 5.00% in September 2024, as a result equity market was supported. Global stock met with high volatility again in late October as investors foresee US election result as uncertain. Finally, US stock rallied strongly after Trump won US presidency from the hope of stimulus and deregulation while non-US equities underperformed because investor fear of trade war, especially China and Vietnam.

Fund's Investment Strategy

The fund mainly invests in units of BNP Paribas Funds Sustainable Multi-Asset Growth (Class I)* (Master fund) at average of not less than 80% of its total net asset value in an accounting period. The Master Fund, which is managed by BNP PARIBAS ASSET MANAGEMENT Luxembourg, seeks to increase the value of its assets over the medium term by investing primarily indirectly (through investments vehicles across multiple asset classes) in issuers selected globally based on their practices and activities linked to sustainable development.

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Unitholders of United Sustainable Thematic Select Fund

Opinion

I have audited the financial statements of United Sustainable Thematic Select Fund ("the Fund"), which comprise the

statement of financial position and details of investments as at 28 February 2025, and the statement of comprehensive

income and statement of changes in net assets for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a

summary of significant accounting policies.

In my opinion, the financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of United Sustainable

Thematic Select Fund as at 28 February 2025, and its financial performance and changes in its net assets for the year then

ended in accordance with the Accounting Guidance for Mutual Funds and Provident Funds issued by the Association of

Investment Management Companies and approved by the Securities and Exchange Commission.

Basis for Opinion

I conducted my audit in accordance with Thai Standards on Auditing. My responsibilities under those standards are further

described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of my report. I am independent

of the Fund in accordance with the Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants, including Independence Standards issued

by the Federation of Accounting Professions (Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants) that are relevant to my audit of

the financial statements, and I have fulfilled my other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the Code of Ethics for

Professional Accountants. I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for

my opinion.

Other Information

Management is responsible for the other information. The other information comprises information including in annual

report but does not include the financial statements and my auditor's report thereon, which is expected to be made available

to me after that date.

My opinion on the financial statements does not cover the other information and I do not and will not express any form of

assurance conclusion thereon.

In preparing the financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the Fund's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the Fund or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

My objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes my opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Thai Standards on Auditing will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 28 FEBRUARY 2025

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

United Sustainable Thematic Select Fund ("the Fund") was registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") on 18 March 2022 with the registered value of Baht 2,000 million (divided into 200 million investment units at Baht 10 each). UOB Asset Management (Thailand) Company Limited ("the Management Company") serves as the Fund's Manager and Investment Unit Registrar and KASIKORNBANK PUBLIC COMPANY LIMITED serves as the Fund's Trustee.

The Fund is an open-ended fund with no stipulated project life, which divides the investment units into 3 classes as follows:

- 1. Normal redemption class for individual investors to earn capital gain and accumulated benefits from total return.
- 2. Auto redemption class for individual investors to earn regularly from the auto redemption.
- 3. Super savings fund class for individual investors to invest to receive tax benefits and expect to receive returns from an increase in investment units in the long-term.

At present, the Fund has open only the Normal redemption class and Super savings fund class.

The Fund's policy is to invest in a foreign unit trust of BNP Paribas Funds Sustainable Multi-Asset Growth (Class I) (Master Fund), (formerly invested in BNP PARIBAS A FUND Sustainable Thematic Select I Cap until 6 March 2024), which is registered and managed by BNP PARIBAS ASSET MANAGEMENT Luxembourg, at the average of not less than 80% of its net asset value. The Master Fund was registered in Luxembourg. Therefore, the Fund may enter into derivative contracts for the purpose of hedging of exchange rate.

The Fund's policy is not to pay dividends to the unitholders.

2. BASIS OF PREPARATION OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The financial statements of the Fund are prepared in accordance with the Accounting Guidance for Mutual Funds and Provident Funds issued by the Association of Investment Management Companies and approved by the SEC ("Accounting Guidance"), while for those matters not covered by the Accounting Guidance, the Fund applies Thai Financial Reporting Standards issued by the Federation of Accounting Professions.

The financial statements of the Fund have been prepared in the Thai language and expressed in Thai Baht. Such financial statements have been prepared for domestic reporting purposes. For the convenience of the readers not conversant with the Thai language, an English version of the financial statements has been provided by translating from the Thai version of the financial statements.

3. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Investments

Investments are recognised as assets at fair value at the date on which the Fund has the right on investments.

Investments in foreign unit trusts are presented at fair value by using the latest value of net assets per unit on the date of investment measurement.

Net unrealised gains or losses arising from their revaluation of investments to be fair value are reflected in profit or loss.

The weighted average method is used to determine the cost of each security at the time of sales.

Revenues and Expenses Recognition

Interest income is recognised as interest accrues, based on the effective interest rate method.

Expenses are recognised on an accrual basis.

On disposal of an investment, the difference between net consideration received and carrying amount is recognised in profit or loss.

Accounts in Foreign Currencies

Accounts in foreign currencies are converted into Baht at the rates of exchange on the transaction date. Assets and liabilities in foreign currencies at the end of the year are converted into Baht at the rates of exchange on that date. The derivative contracts are converted at the contract rates on the transaction date.

Outstanding derivative contracts are marked to market by comparing contract rates to forward rates established by the contracting bank with same maturity. At the end of the year, the unrealised gains or losses on outstanding derivative contracts, calculated as described above, are included within accounts receivable or accounts payable from derivative contracts in statement of financial position.

Foreign exchange differences are recognised in profit or loss.

Income Tax

The Fund shall pay income tax according to the Revenue Code based on income under section 40 (4) (a) at the rate of 15% of income before deducting expenses.

Use of Accounting Judgments and Estimates

Preparation of financial statements in conformity with Accounting Guidance requires management to make judgments and estimates that affect the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, revenues, expenses and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities. Actual results may differ from those estimates.

The judgments and estimates are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Revisions to accounting estimates are recognised prospectively.

8. DISCLOSURE OF FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS

Fair Value Estimation

Fair value is the price that would be received from sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between buyers and sellers (market participants) at the measurement date. The Fund used quoted prices in active markets in measuring assets and liabilities which required to be measured at fair value under related accounting guidance. In case that there is no active markets for identical assets or liabilities or the quoted prices in active markets are not available, the Fund will estimate the fair value using valuation techniques that fit to each circumstance and try to use observable data that is relevant to the assets or liabilities to be measured as much as possible.

The following table shows fair value of financial instruments categorised by measurement approach with different levels in a fair value hierarchy as follows:

- Level 1: quoted prices (unadjusted) in active markets for identical assets or liabilities.
- Level 2: inputs other than quoted prices included in Level 1 that are observable for the asset or liability, either directly (i.e. as prices) or indirectly (i.e. derived from prices).
- Level 3: inputs for the asset or liability that are not based on observable market data (unobservable inputs).

The Fund entered into derivative contracts for hedging exchange rates on investments in foreign currency (see Note 6).

Market Risk

The Fund is exposed to the market risk from changes in market prices with respect to its investments in foreign unit trust. The returns on investments fluctuate depending on the economic and political situation including the status of financial and capital markets. The mentioned situations may affect the operation of the financial instruments' issuers in a positive or negative way depending on the kind of business of those issuers and how they relate with fluctuating market, which may arise to an increase or decrease of the financial instruments' market price.

Risk Management

The fund manager of BNP Paribas Funds Sustainable Multi-Asset Growth (Class I) will analyse any factors which may affect price and the said fund has a policy to invest in various funds that have undergone a screening process and are considered best-in-class funds. These funds invest in both equities and fixed income instruments. The screening process evaluates issuers or companies based on their responsibility toward society and the environment, along with strong corporate governance practices. The Fund may also consider Sustainable Thematic factors. The investment allocation consists of 75% in equities and 25% in fixed income instruments.

9. APPROVAL OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

These financial statements have been approved for issue by the authorised persons of the Fund on 9 April 2025.
